Facility: 8 lane 25 yard pool; 6 lanes will be used for competition; one lane will be available for warm-up/cool-down throughout the meet with one lane as a buffer. Automatic timing with watch back-up. Deck space is ample; you may wish to bring a deck chair or cushion. Well-stocked concession stand.

Entry limit: 5 individual events plus three relay events. The relays will be seeded by time and will be run concurrently.

Fees: \$4.00 per individual event for pre-registration. \$5.00 per relay (payable on the day of the meet); all relay swimmers must be entered in the meet. Relays only surcharge of \$5.50. For pre-registration, entries must be IN OUR HANDS no later than March 9, 2010. Please make checks payable to Elgin Blue Wave. Deck entries. Deck entries for individual events will be accepted on the day of the meet until 7:30am at a cost of \$5.50 per event. No deck entries will be accepted for the 200 freestyle.

Awards: Each entrant will receive an award certificate. Team awards will be presented to the top three teams; team awards must be picked up by your team representative on the day of the event. Illinois Masters members please note: you must list your team (workout group) affiliation on your entry form or you will be listed as independent.

Seeding: heats will be run slowest to fastest regardless of age or gender. Relays will be in 10 year increments.

Eligibility: valid 2010 USMS registration required, no exceptions. In accordance with USMS rules a photocopy of your registration card must be provided.

Pool measurement: Our facility has been measured and found to comply with USMS regulations so that times will be eligible for top ten consideration. Please let us know if you think you may set a national record so that the appropriate paperwork can be prepared to document your achievement.
